**Part-3: (Resource Person: Anwasha Rana, Editor – Academic Publishing)**

1. The workshop will focus on the norms of academic publishing and guide the audience through the nuances of academic writing and making submission for publication.
2. This will include a discussion on *how to select a journal, writing abstract, benefits of publication, cover letter*, submissions, *peer review, publishing ethics* and open access.
3. The importance and methods of references, **citations**, permissions and **copyright clearance** will be focused upon.
4. The discussion will also cover **plagiarism**, techniques and software’s used by publishers to detect plagiarism and the threats and risks of self-plagiarism, which is a commonly misunderstood term.
